### **Rules / Requirements**

1. Gates open at 7:00am for cooking teams.
2. All teams must be in place and all support vehicles out by 9:00am on Saturday.
3. Festival gates open at 11:00am Saturday morning.
4. Teams must provide all cooking supplies. No electricity provided.
5. All fresh ingredients must be prepared on sight.
6. Roux can be prepared in advance. Pre-cooked seafood/meats are ok.
7. Teams must provide water. Pre-packaged bottled water only. No hydrant.
8. No glass containers allowed. Metal, plastic, and paper only.
9. Teams must have fire extinguisher.
10. Teams responsible for trash removal and area cleanup.
11. Teams must be prepared to serve samples. 10 gallons of gumbo required.  
Serving cups and spoons will be provided by festival.
12. Blind judging decisions are final.
13. Special categories will be determined based on number of entries.
14. Prizes and awards will be presented on the main stage at 5:00pm.
